All courses are in line with typical skill level difficulties, although the White course is a bit on the short side so any beginner wanting a bit more of a workout is encouraged to try the Yellow course.

Event timing will be standard: register anytime between 10:45 - 1:15, start between 11 - 1:30, and be back before the controls start being picked up at 3pm.
