Come out and celebrate the **6th annual Super Bowl Saturday Bumble AND enjoy QOC's Winter Meeting and Pot Luck Party!**

This year we head to Patapsco to enjoy terrain that includes an intricate trail system sprinkled with some steep but fun areas. In addition to the Bumble Mass Start event for advanced participants (see *photo - can Chris Gross defend his Blue Bumble Title?*), there will also be White and Orange level courses available. PLEASE read the notes below for important details about the courses and the party. Registration, downloading, and the post-race party will be in the **Cafeteria of the Student Services Center (SSRV) of the Community College of Baltimore County - Catonsville**. - We do NOT have access to a kitchen:
  - Please keep items that need refrigeration in a cooler (or in your car if it's a cold day).
  - Feel free to bring crock pots; there are plenty of outlets.
  - Please bring serving utensils for your dish.
- NO alcohol allowed; QOC will provide non-alcoholic beverages, cups, utensils and paper goods.



- NO spikes allowed in Student Services Center.
- We have access to restrooms in the building but PLEASE do not wear muddy shoes into the facility. Change them before you come in! There is also a port-a-john available in Lot 6.

Parking is plentiful, and we have permission to use two lots. Lot 5 is next to Student Services Center. Lot 6 is where the start is located and is a very short walk to the SSRV (about 400 meters – see locator map below).

Because of the mass-start we will **open registration at 10:00 am**. Please be sure to arrive early to avoid a last minute rush. **Important notes:**

- Beginners are welcome (just like 99% of our events!)
- White and Orange courses will have regular starts from 11:00am to 1:30pm.
- The advanced courses (Beige, Brown, Mint, Green, Pink, Red, Blue) will have a MASS START at 11:30am allowing Bumpers to have up to 3.5 hours to complete their course due to some areas with steep terrain. Please be ready for the PRE-RACE briefing at 11:15am in Lot 6.
- We will have a clothing drop at the start; clothes will be available for pick up in the Cafeteria.
- Everyone must be out of the woods by 3:00pm, which is when we will begin picking up controls.
- Bumble prizes will be awarded for:
  - first male and first female to cross the finish (from the mass start) regardless of course
  - fastest competitor on the Blue course
- Dogs are welcome in the park and on campus, but they must be on leashes. They cannot enter the Cafeteria unless they are legally certified service dogs.
